## Student Events and Meetings:

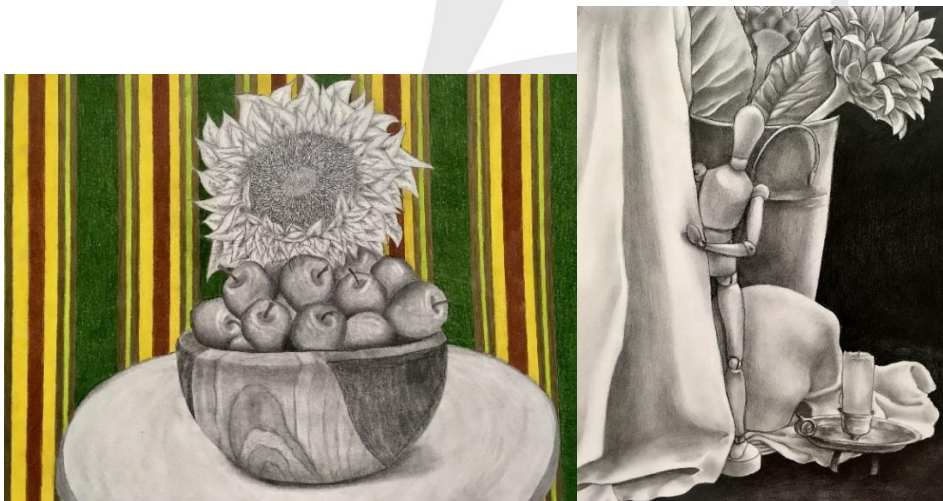
