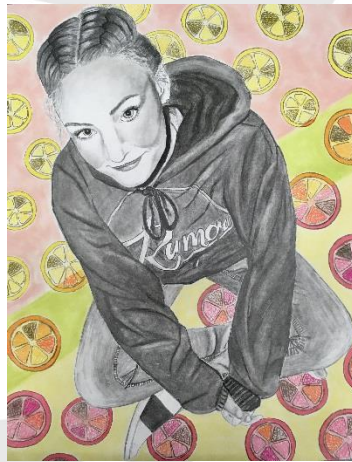
University of Alberta Debate Team, who is going to coach these two clubs. If you have any questions, please see Mrs. Allen.
