- **Dungeons & Dragons:** Meeting today in room 174 at lunchtime today. Newcomers appreciated, everyone welcome

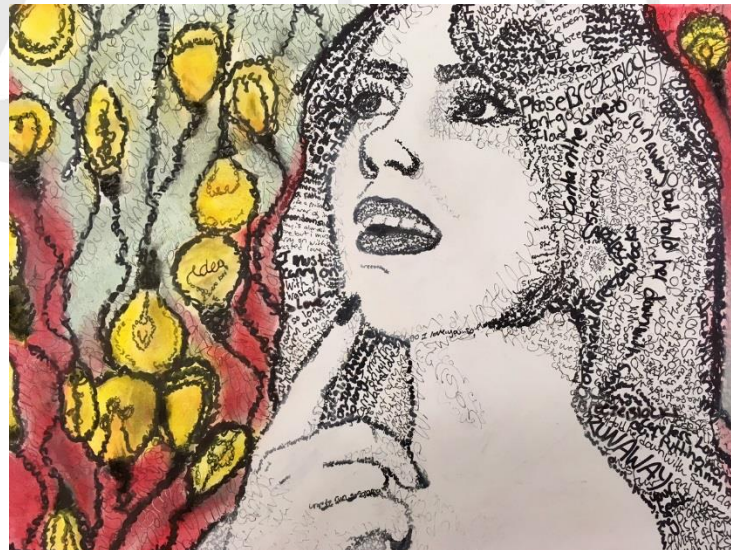
Grad:
