At Northlands Expo Centre (Hall D)

- Last year they did not charge us to park, however, please be prepared to pay just in case.
- Rehearsal should be completed by 5:30 p.m.
- Grad Gown Pick-up – immediately after rehearsal (Room 301)

Commencement at Northlands

June 9th, 2018 1:00-3:00pm

At Northlands Expo Centre (Hall D)

- Tickets will be on sale at the beginning of May.
- Students must arrive no later than **12:00 p.m. (with Gown & Cap)**.
- Ceremony begins at 1:00 p.m. and concludes at 3:00 p.m.
- Parking will be extremely busy and may take longer than expected. Please plan to arrive early. Last year the cost for parking was \$9.00 for the day. Please mention that you are there for the Salisbury Composite Grad.
- All guests will require a ticket in order to enter Hall D for the ceremony.
- Students are to return the Grad Gown within 30 minutes of the ceremony. Students are to keep the cap.
- **Students who have not returned their gown or who have returned a gown that is damaged will be charged for the cost of the gown.**

- **Grad DVD pre-sale** is available on Acorn or in the General Office at a cost of **\$25**. This cost will increase to **\$30.00 after June 9th**.
