- **Check that you are on the final Grad List before you purchase tickets.**

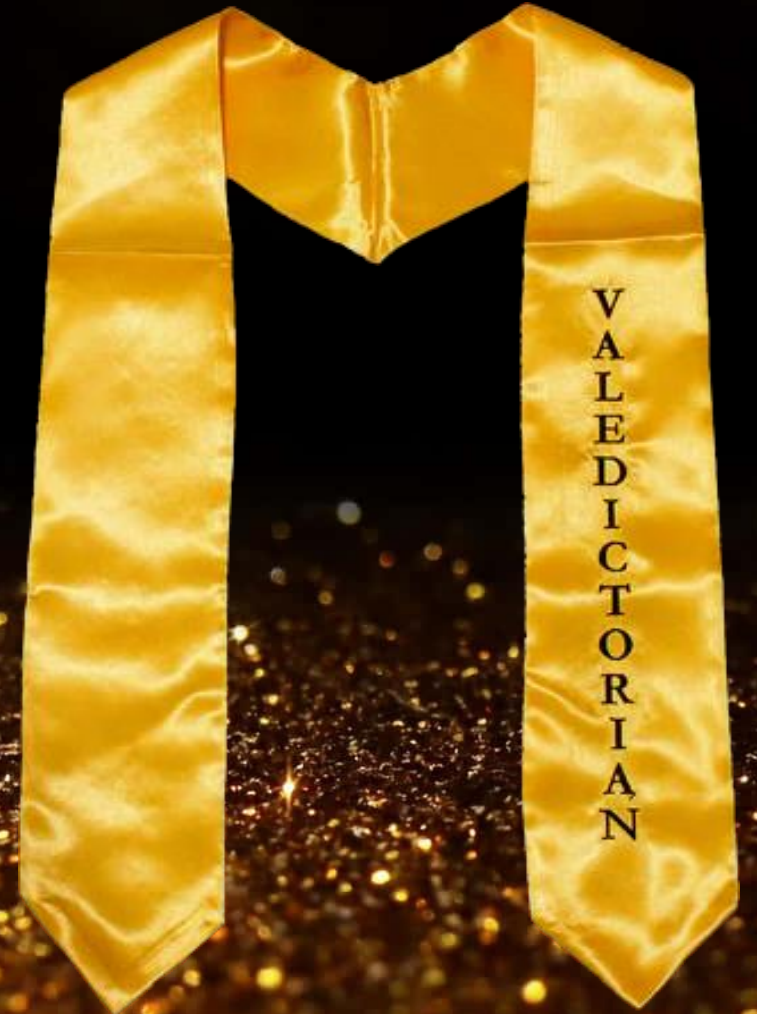


# Valedictorian


Valedictorian – by definition, is the student with the highest academic average in their senior year who delivers the valedictory speech at graduation.

Following the example of the Alexander Rutherford Criteria, at SAL, we use all grade 12 (or 30 level) course marks in our calculation. ELA must be used along with the top four marks from all other subjects to calculate an average for each student based on the five marks. The student with the highest average is named the valedictorian.

The valedictorian is usually decided upon in Mid-May.

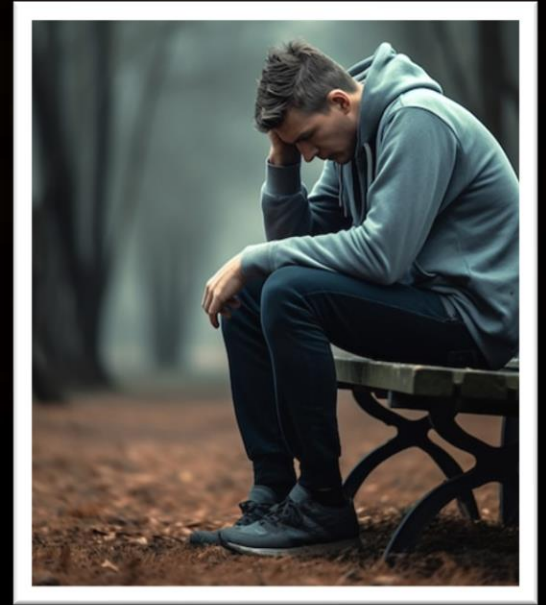

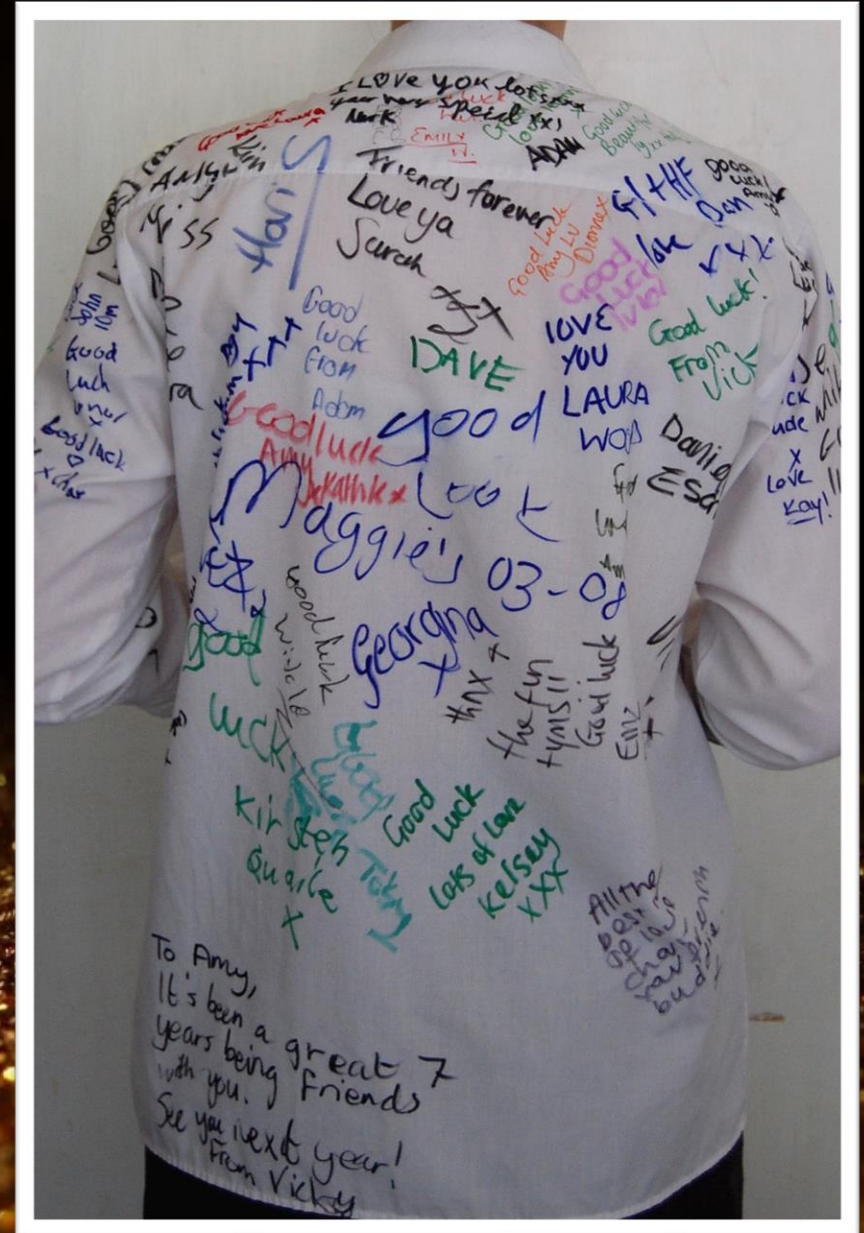
- Theme Day

# Quick background

- **3 levels of government**
  - Federal
  - Provincial
  - **Municipal**
- **Strathcona County decisions are made by our County Council**
  - You have a specific Councilor for the ward you live in
- **Public engagement** is when we go out to members of the public and ask for their input on specific topics
- **Council BEGS us to find out what youth think about specific projects or issues, but we almost never hear a thing**

# Why should you care?

- Do you have the same needs as your grandma?
- Do you hope to live or work here when you are done school?
- Are there things that bother you about our community, or things that you love and want to support / expand?



# What we know

- Youth are less satisfied overall than all other age groups
- People overall give Strathcona County a lower rating as a "place to start out in life"
- We need to hear what youth need / want so that your needs aren't drowned out by the voice of older generations
- We want to keep youth in the County for the long term to have a strong and vibrant community

# County Voice

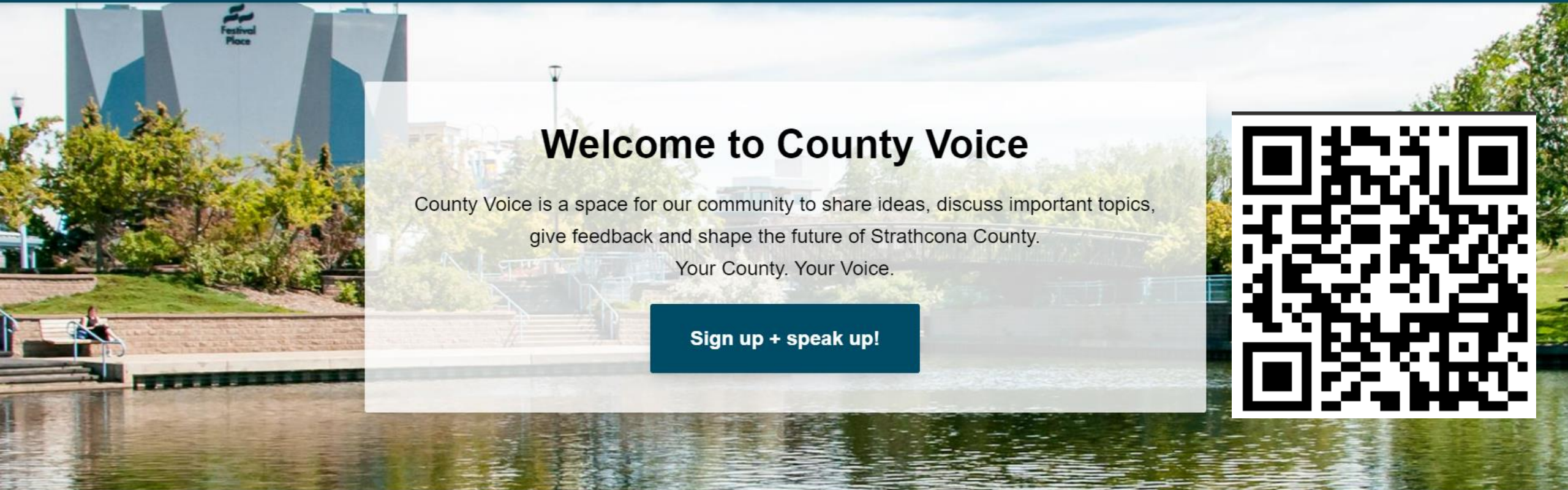
- Engagement doesn't need to take much work

# Money Matters

- Every fall Council approves a budget that decides what we do for the community over the coming years
- This includes day-to-day stuff like how we operate rec facilities or plow roads, and also future stuff like whether we have money to build a new fire hall or road

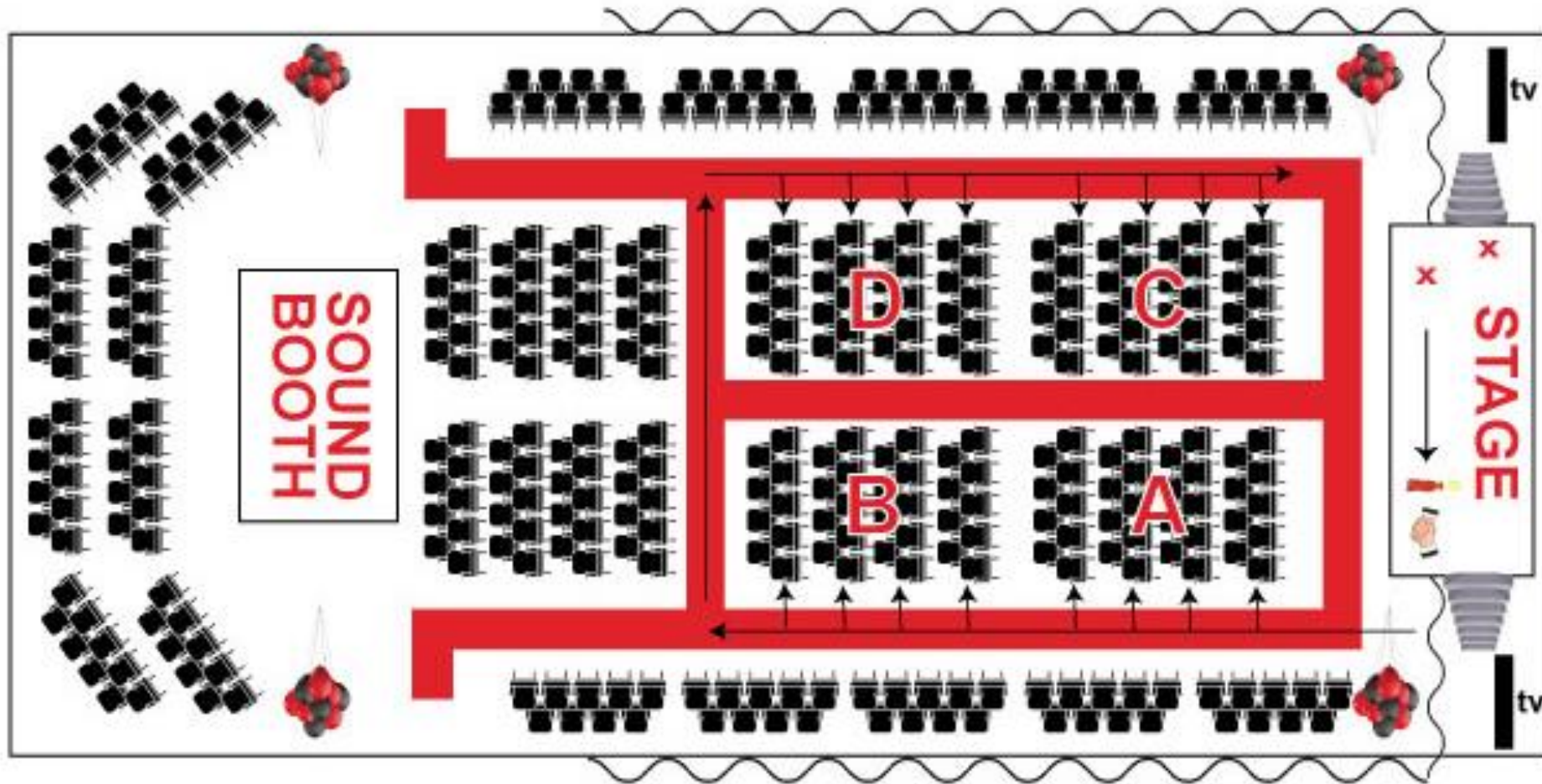
# Commencement:
