Walk for Wenjack began in 2016 as a grassroots event organized by a dedicated team of volunteers. The first walk retraced the steps of Chanie Wenjack, a 12-year-old Anishinaabe boy who died after escaping residential school. He was attempting to reach his family 600km away.
